







Between two perfect worlds.




Your Building






Extraordinary from the moment you arrive.

Green spaces and gardens are central to the ethos of Ironwood. Indeed, nature's serenity is infused into every facet of the building's design, both inside and out.




"IT IS US III"

a "community within a community".










Your Spaces

The mezzanine.



Family room.


In addition to an outdoor play area, Ironwood accords multiple spaces for children and families indoors—including a shared family room and adjacent music room.
