PUBLIC INTERFACE

The proposed design for 1468 Alberni is comprised of two towers that rise from a townhouse scaled base. A variety of window types lend the building a residential character. The lower third of the towers create a midheight that refers to the scale of Vancouver buildings from the early twentieth century.
