This warranty is transferable to whomever owns the property, providing contractor is notified in writing of any change of ownership. Water Evacuation and Sump Systems, and Basement Air Systems, are covered by a separate 2- year manufacturers warranty. These warranties can be extended under the "Extended Lifetime Maintenance and Warranty" option.

[Extended Lifetime Maintenance and Warranty option]:For an annual sum of \$78.00, paid on the second anniversary of the completion date Contractor will extend the warranty on all Water Evacuation and Sump Systems, and the Basement Air Systems (filters not included), for as long as you own your home. This agreement is transferable to whomever owns the property provided the maintenance fees are paid by new owner, and Basement Systems is notified in writing of any change in ownership. This fee also includes an annual maintenance check by Contractor's technician to test the components of the systems installed, including mechanical equipment and filters. New filters are installed at homeowners expense.]

Contractor is not responsible for, and the warranty does not cover ,dampness and condensation as a result of high humidity, on walls and floor, or water entering the premises through, or as a result of, steps, stainwells, chimneys, windows, conduit pipes, sill plates, above soil level, back up of sewers, flood conditions, or sump capacity during flood conditions, as well as crawl spaces where drainage and or Water Evacuation Systems were NOT installed. We are not responsible for consequential water or property damages, nor areas not contracted in this agreement. While eliminating excess moisture in the basement is important to controlling mold and mildew, Contractor makes NO claim or warranty against mold growth and or health effects as a result of mold growth.

On stone, brick, and tile foundations, or foundation walls that show excessive signs of vapor transmission, Contractor is not responsible for moisture or seepage unless a Vapor Barrier is installed. Contractor is not responsible for damage as a result of pump failures, or lines run to pump from existing appliances or other discharge lines. If power outages are a common occurrence, or basement is carpeted, Contractor suggests the purchase of a Batter Back-up Water Evacuation or Sump System. Buyer understands that a battery back-up system operates off limited battery power, and it is the Buyer's responsibility to restore power to the primary system prior to the exhaustion of the battery power. Buyer is responsible for the installation of electrical outlets if necessary. If using the Buyer's existing sump system, Contractor cannot warranty against seepage due to the failure of that system.

All warranties are null and void if Contractor's work has been changed or modified by any other entity.

A CleanSpace, crawl space encapsulation system will isolate the home from the earth. The humidity level in the air will be lowered, reducing moisture needed for mold growth, however the encapsulation system does not claim to be a mold mitigation system. Wet crawl spaces require a drainage system, and a SmartSump system to remedy the problem with water below the CleanSpace liner. CleanSpace has a transferable 25 year warranty — there will be no charge for service calls on any tears orholes in the CleanSpace liner, in the unlikely event this occurs.


