The school is named after Jesse Ketchum, a philanthropist who donated the land to the School Board to build the school and to the city for the park. The school serves a diverse population of approximately 400 students, whose cultural backgrounds represent many countries from around the world. There are more than 40 different languages spoken in the homes of our students. At Jesse Ketchum our students build self-esteem and confidence, learn to work together in mutual respect and trust, and value diversity.

How We Determine Our HoodQ Scores

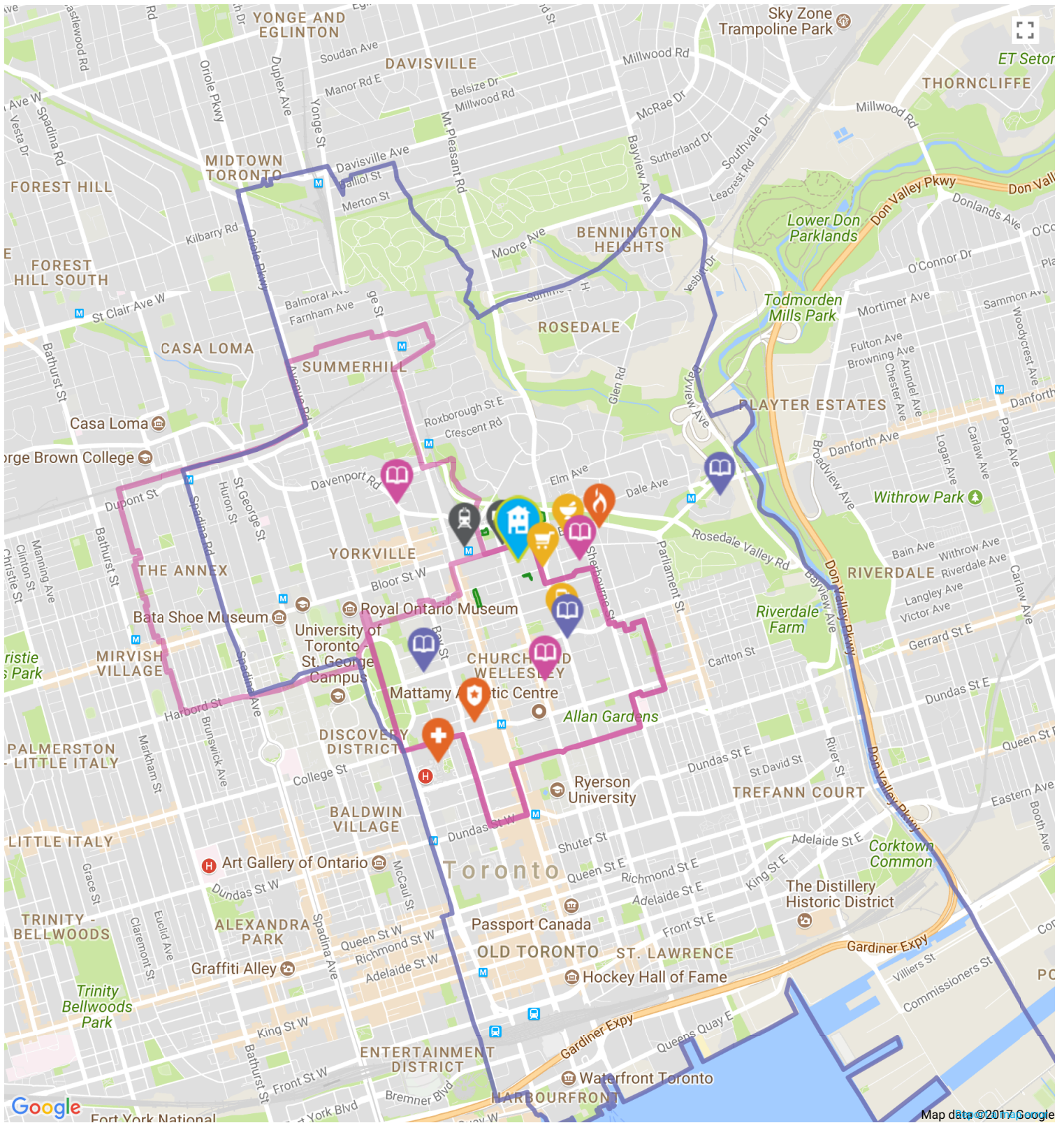
School ratings and rankings were obtained from the Fraser Institute, which provides school ratings and rankings based on objective, publicly-available academic performance indicators

The Parks & Recreation Score is based on two factors - the number of parks and recreation centres near this address and the number of facilities available at those locations.

The Transit Score is based on proximity to public transit access points, both Street-Level and Rail, including buses, streetcars, subways, and trains.

The Safety Score is based on proximity to emergency service agencies, specifically Fire Stations, Police Stations, and Hospitals.

The Convenience Score is based on proximity to Gas Stations, Pharmacies, and Grocery Stores.
