The town of Bracebridge has fabulous amenities, a choice of good restaurants, a South Muskoka Memorial Hospital with emergency services, public and separate schools, (Monk Public French Immersion), and 2 High Schools. The school district is Trillium Lakelands and Monck Public School is the designated elementary school for this area. Bracebridge Muskoka Lakes Secondary School is on the north side of town and shares a large space with a state-of-the-art Sportsplex, Pool, and the Rene M Caisse Theatre.

There are many parks and walking trails within short driving and walking distances from this location. It is a lovely short stroll to Annie Williams Park and to the famous Bracebridge Falls. Kelvin Grove Park with a large children's playground, pickleball courts, a rowing club, a boat launch, and a beach, found just down the river's edge trail!

Golfers enjoy a choice of Golf Courses with the Muskoka Highlands, Kerrie Glen or the South Muskoka Golf and Curling Club where social events happen all year long.

There is an active Seniors' Living Center, an indoor skating arena and soon to be built is a dual pad skating rink with an additional Library. There are too many sports clubs, service clubs, and community groups to name and no shortage of fun things to participate in every beautiful season in Bracebridge.
